



### **Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**

God tells Jonah in Sunday's First Reading to "set out for the great city of Ninevah, and announce to it the message that I will tell you." He walked through this "enormously large city", announcing to its people that it would be destroyed in forty days. Jonah's words and action here might seem crazy to someone who knows nothing of God. In the Gospel Reading, Jesus called the fishermen John: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." They left everything-boats, nets, fish, family-and followed Him immediately. This would not seem to a worldly man to be a well thought out, sane action. But consider what motivated them. God in the souls of Jonah and the first apostles moved them to ac-


