#### **Updated Voting Requirements**

A Federal District Court Judge has ruled that Texas must modify its photo voter ID law to allow voters to cast a regular ballot in an election after showing an alternative identification and signing a simple declaration form.

Identification Requirements for Voting Under Texas law, voters who possess one of the seven acceptable forms of photo ID must present that ID at the polls when voting in person. Voters who do not possess and cannot reasonably obtain one of the seven approved forms of photo ID may fill out a Reasonable Impediment Declaration (RID) (PDF) at the polls and present an alternative form of ID, such as a utility bill, bank statement, government check, or a voter registration certificate.

#### Here is a list of the acceptable forms of photo ID:

Texas Driver License issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS

Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS

Texas Handgun License issued by DPS United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph United States Passport (book or card)

With the exception of the U.S. Citizenship Certificate, which does not expire, for voters aged 18-69, the acceptable form of photo identification may be expired no more than four years before being presented for voter qualification at the polling place. For voters aged 70 or older, the acceptable form of photo identification may be expired for any length of time if the identification is otherwise valid. Election Identification Certificates are available from DPS driver license offices during regular business hours

What to do if you don't have any of the above ID or Documents? A voter who cannot present the above

forms of photo ID or supporting documents may still cast a PROVISIONAL ballot. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*
