This makes Jesus' parable in today's Gospel all the more sig- make room in our hearts and minds nificant:

A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell on the path, and must be willing to work for peace and birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had little soil. *It sprang up at once because the soil* was not deep, and when the sun rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of roots. Some seeds fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil, and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.

As parish communities, what are we doing to cultivate the seeds that have been entrusted to us? Do we provide ample, rich soil for seeds to grow, or a culture that is not conducive— even is God who waters the lands and detrimental—to healthy flourishing? fying grace and weaponizing sacraments? Do we perpetuate thorns by crafting divisions and distinctions that to this invitation with renewed zeal, are not of God? Do we leave people vulnerable to isolation and fear, insisting that we know best instead of listening and accompanying?

We must be willing to for other voices, even when they challenge what we find comfortable. We justice, even when it is not convenient. We must be willing not only to advocate for, but to stand in solidarity with the immigrant and refugee, the person who lives without a home, and the person who lives with anxiety and depression. We must combat the evils of abuse, racism, sexism, xenophobia, and homophobia in all forms. In doing so, we cultivate an environment where seeds can grow, where people can thrive.
